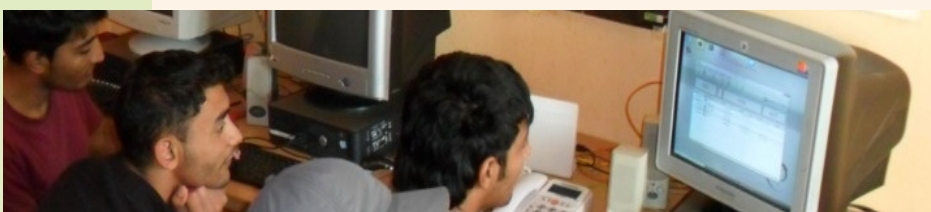
The departments created, various forms, storage, legal and business systems are designed to facilitate the transactions and negotiation between youths that manage those departments.
